2. Friday, Saturday and Sunday, to help setup, clean up and general help with the festival with assigned Jobs.
3. Activities that will be assigned may be Sharky's restaurant, parking lot help, runners, bussing tables, kids space help, Etc. whatever the event needs for help to be a success.
3. Beneficiaries will be required to help breakdown the event on Sunday night and put it back in storage.
